Variety is the word to best describe Ascension Bay & Boca Paila

Ascension Bay is around 90+ square miles of large sand flats that allow for wade fishing in shallower water or searching in 3'-6' deeper flats via panga.

Bonefish, permit, tarpon and snook are the 4 species that come to mind when one thinks about Ascension Bay but barracuda, a variety of jacks, ladyfish, snapper etc. are roaming the waters too! If it's your day, a Grand Slam or a Super Grand Slam may be within reach. Whether you are a beginner or expert angler, Ascension Bay has something to offer.

Ascension Bay and Boca Paila Lagoon systems offer all types of species and scenarios that anglers may be looking for. Truly some of the best salt water variety in the world.

Image wading a sand or turtle grass flat while sight fishing for tailing and cruising bonefish. Perhaps get lucky and stumble across a permit unexpectedly. Maybe you just wish to pursue the elusive permit from the boat, poling in hopes of the opportunity to exit the boat and getting that "shot" or even better, the "eat"! Others may want to explore the mangrove lagoons, channels and creeks for tarpon and weary snook. Casting can prove to be challenging in this environment, how ever sometimes opportunities happen on open flats.













Besides the consistency of bonefishing, the challenge of permit, the thrill of rolling tarpon or a snook exploding on your fly, some will find the power of a Jack Crevalle or the fierce strike of a barracuda just as satisfying. Whatever it is you're after, Ascension Bay can provide an unforgettable experience.

Light tackle or fly fishermen will find bonefish, permit, juvenile tarpon, snook and jacks year round. Migratory tarpon start arriving in the spring offering larger fish and more consistency. Snook fishing is best Oct. - Dec.

Peak season goes from mid November to June. More and more anglers are taking advantage of our seasonal discounts (20% June 15 - Oct. 31, 10% Nov. 1 - Feb. 28, but not including Dec. 18 - Jan. 4)

We are located in the heart of the Sian Ka'an Biosphere Reserve and to enjoy it we have prepared a series of adventures and a game to make it interesting with a small competition that will keep the kids very excited. (Young and Old)

Every day we will go out by boat looking for birds, crustaceans, reptiles, molluscs, fish, mammals, plants



We prepared charts with pictures and their names, each team has to take a picture of each one of the subjects to gain points.

In the morning your Naturalist guide will give you a briefing about life cycle and tips to understand where they are and what they are doing, like dolphins mating or playing etc.

During the day we will walk, snorkel, kayak and take boat rides looking for them, each team will have to capture them on camera to earn points.



Everyday before dinner, we will review the pictures and give extra bonuses to the best images.

By the end of the week you will notice that the group is more aware of the infinite number of fishes in the reef and will be able to recognize by name, most of the animals and know how they mate, grow and reproduce.

They will be seeing dolphins, turtles, manatees, reef fish, corals, mangroves, marine birds, crocodiles, eagles, spoon bills, flamingos, conch, reptiles and much more.

The group will have a better understanding of the marine eco system and have an unforgettable experience.





The lodge is located 90 miles south of Cancun, inside the 1.3 million acres of The Sian Ka'an Biosphere Reserve, (Mayan for "where the sky is born"). It is virtually surrounded by water. To the East lies the turquoise Caribbean and a few hundred yards offshore the Palancar Barrier Reef (2nd largest to Great Barrier Reef) which streteches from Southern Belize to North of Cancun. On the Western side lies the vast "El Rio" system of flats, chanels and mangroves known as Boca Paila Lagoon. Approximately 10 miles North is the famous inlet through the barrier reef known as the "Boca" or mouth which constantly rejuvenates the lagoon with the incoming and outgoing tides. It is a virtual fish highway allowing all fish species to come and go at will into th delicate ecosystem. Just 4 miles to the South is where Boca Paila Lagoon and the magnificent Ascension Bay meet. The location of the lodge is ideal for easy access to the bay or lagoon depending on weather and where your target species have most recently ben seen.







We can take up to 16 anglers in the 2 beachfront homes consisteing of 4 rooms each. All rooms have private baths, hot and cold showers, A/C, ocean views and balconies overlooking the beach.


The lodge also has a large palapa, housing an open bar, small fly shop, common area, and is also where breakfast and dinner, appeizers, drinks and snacks are prepared and served.
